4 Major Productions Student Participation Fees (Below are the costs associated with each production.

These fees are <u>nonrefundable</u> if the student chooses to drop after 1st week of the production process. If a student does not pay the Production fee by the deadline, the Production fee increases by \$25 unless a student, parent, or guardian contacts Mrs. Palmer or Mrs. Moraschinelli in regard to the "Note" above):

1) Fall Production – High School Cast and Crew Positions Available!

2) Winter Musical – Middle School and High School Cast Positions Available and High School Crew Positions Available!
